It was certainly a night to remember for all!


















INNOVATION DAY

This was followed by high tea for all. All in all, it was a day full of fun and frolic!


















INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON PROMOTING HAPPINESS THROUGH PUBLIC POLICY








PROJECT MANAGEMENT



WHAT IS A RESEARCH ANALYST?

A research analyst is responsible for researching, analyzing, interpreting, and presenting data related to markets, operations, finance/accounting, economics, customers, and other information related to the field they work in.
