


## **Annual Convocation 2020**


The graduating students were awarded Diplomas and Degrees. Meritorious students from both the programs were awarded, as well.


















## **Careers in FinTech**



His advice to the participants was to develop themselves in emerging areas like HR analytics etc. since analytics has become very important of late and hence it is important to learn the skill.











The webinar was attended by the Director, Dean, Faculty, Staff and Students of IILM Lucknow.


## Knowledge, Skills and Attitude to excel in the Retail Industry




